regarding Amateur License Plates:

Amateur radio license plates (quote from email)

I have saved the most important item for last. As most of you probably know there is a problem with the issuing of VA6 prefixed amateur radio license plates. Because these plates are essentially treated as personalized license plates they go through the same review process as all other personalized license plates. It is at this review point where the committee has flagged these plates as inappropriate. Former club president Mltch, VE6OH, and I met with the registrar a few years ago to work on a resolution. As I recall from that, the real solution would require intervention at the ministerial or legislative level. Given the upcoming election I thought this would be a good time for us as a community to work together on a strategy to address this. As I see it there are two basic options:

- 1. Have the minister issue a directive to the personalized license plate review committee to approve all ham plates without review. This would resolve the issue. But, the registry guidelines already asy this and it is still a problem
- 2. The better (to me) and longer term solution is to have ham plates enshrined in legislation the same way veteran plates are, complete with a special amateur radio plate design. I have included a possible plate design (mine) below. We could also leverage the centennial of amateur radio when lobbying for this change. This would have two benefits. The first would be to solve the VA6 problem as the review process would be eliminated, and the second would be to raise the profile of amateur radio in the province. Alberta introduced the amateur radio license plate in 1958 (https://drive.google.com/file/d/190am6pJ9_R7BH-AS_u7HP6jO3U7_O5-A/view?usp=sharing). I believe Quebec was the first jurisdiction to issue ham plates in 1952. I am happy to lead this important initiative and craft teh letter to the minister. It is my hope that as many amateur radio clubs as possible in Alberta, along with RAC as the national body, would sign the letter in support. I would hope to have something ready to go within a few weeks of the new government being formed.
